Amará Malbec - Syrah

FACT SHEET

60% Malbec - 40% Syrah

Manual Harvest: Year 2018

Alcohol: 14%.

Malbec Vineyards: Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza.

Syrah: Perdriel, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza.

Harvest in boxes of 20 kg. of chosen parcels.

Manual selection of bunches.

Traditional elaboration in stainless steel tanks with native yeasts. Spontaneous malolactic fermentation.

Aging: 18 months in barrels on French of first, second and third use.

Production: 6,000 bottles

Aging Potential: 15 years

TASTING NOTES

High complexity nose, fruity aromas appear and spices.

Very balanced, smooth, fruity wine, with firm and ripe tannins. Certain mineral and vanilla notes are perceived due to its aging in oak. Excellent and persistent finish.

A wine that can be drunk, glass after glass. It is recommended to accompany roast lamb, game meats or stews, mushroom-based dishes and strong cheeses.
