Crafted in the ovoid cement vessels of our winery.

40% of the wine made is breeded for several months in French oak used barrels.

A young, fruity and easy to drink malbec that frankly reflects the intensity of its terroir.

Ideal to accompany good moments of daily life.

Petit Blousson Malbec is the gateway to the concept of honest and natural wines from Finca Blousson.

Vintage: Hand harvested in 2016 Varietal:100% Malbec.

Vineyards: Distrito los Chacayes, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

Date of plantation: 2010. Altitude: 4.300 fts. over the sea level at the foot of the Cordillera de los Andes

Alcohol Fermentation: Natural yeasts, in ovoidal vessels.

Malolactic Fermentation: in used french barrels and ovoidal vessels.

Aging: 60% in ovoidal vessels / 40% in french used barrels for 12 months.

Alcohol: 13% vol.

Production: 5.000 bottles.
